Letter of commitment and trip application
June 19 to June 26, 2018

LaUnion, Honduras

This year, Lakeshore Fellowship continues its partnership with Aldea Development and the small village of LaCuesta. This trip will be an opportunity to strengthen our relationship with the people of LaCuesta and continue to help them with water related projects.

Physically, participants will encounter travel on rough roads (by truck or bus,) hiking over hilly terrain, higher elevations, a warm climate and different foods. Safe food and water are provided.

Accommodations are dormitory style, with bunk beds, running water, flush toilets, and warm showers. Linens, pillows and a towels is provided.

The cost of the trip this year will be approximately \$1600 per person which includes airfare and on the ground costs. Fundraising opportunities can be coordinated by trip members.

If you are interested in traveling to Honduras, please review the following important considerations:

1. I agree to pay all expenses related to my trip such as passport fees, CDC pre-trip immunizations, airfare, food, lodging and other expenses due to Lakeshore Fellowship Church
2. I will be aware of all deadlines for submission of funds and documents and have all funds and documents submitted by those dates (all required documents are available at lakeshorefellowshipchurch.com.)
3. I understand that when I authorize Lakeshore Fellowship to purchase my airfare, that I am responsible for the cost of the ticket, even if I do not travel.
4. I understand that I must have a current passport, which expires after December 27, 2018.
5. I will be responsive to the counsel and suggestions of the GO Team leaders without questioning authority or judgment.
6. I understand the importance of attending pre-trip meetings, and will notify the group leader if unable to attend.
7. I agree that personal behavior will be above reproach as a representative of LFC and more importantly, the body of Christ.

8. I agree to make necessary lifestyle adjustments in order to adapt to the culture of the host community. This may include altering eating habits, dress style, interactions with group members or Hondurans.
9. I agree to comply with any specific regulations and rules of conduct set in place for my safety.

I realize that these guidelines have been created for my safety and in accordance with the policies of LFC. Violation of this agreement may result in the termination of your trip and returning home at your personal expense.
